Are solar panels good for sheep?

Sheep living in pasture with solar panels benefit from shade in hot weather and more nutritious grass- and they stop weeds from growing on the panels Sheep living among rows of solar panels spend more time grazing, benefit from more nutritious food, rest more and appear to experience less heat stress, compared with nearby sheep in empty fields.

Can sheep graze on solar panels?

Blueberries aren't the only crop researchers want to pair with solar panels. One farm up Maine's coast lets sheep roam around panels installed there. And it's not alone. Silicon Ranch, a company based in Nashville, Tenn., is installing solar panels at 17 farms with sheep. Their grazing keeps the grass low, which means no one has to mow.

Are sheep better than goats on solar farms?

There are a few reasons sheep are the superior choicefor grazing on solar farms. For one, they are shorter than cows and horses. They will also eat most kinds of forage, which helps keep plant growth at bay. Goats, on the other hand, will chew pretty much anything, which is a bit of a risk on solar farms.
