



Can I pay with WeChat for State Grid

What is WeChat Pay?

WeChat Pay is a payment feature integrated into the WeChat app, allowing users to complete payments quickly and securely on their mobile phones. Users can link their bank cards, receive and transfer money, pay bills, and make purchases both in-store and online. Download WeChat from the App Store or Google Play.

How do I set up WeChat Pay?

To set up WeChat Pay, essential documents are needed: a valid Passport or Foreign Permanent Resident ID Card, plus an international bank card for linking. Complete real-name verification with your ID and bank details to enable Quick Payment. No Chinese bank account? You can still link foreign credit cards or bank accounts to WeChat Wallet.

Can foreigners use WeChat Pay?

Foreigners can link international credit cards (Visa, MasterCard) to WeChat Pay. Input your card details, and ensure your card supports international transactions. Verification might involve a small transaction to confirm the card's validity. If you have a Chinese bank account, you can directly top up your WeChat wallet from this account.

Who is eligible for WeChat overseas remittance?

Only Chinese users-- including those from Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan - who have successfully completed real-name authentication are eligible for the WeChat Pay and Alipay international transfer feature. WeChat Overseas Remittance is only available to users who have linked a bank card in Mainland China to their WeChat Pay account.

How do I link a credit card to WeChat Pay?

This usually requires providing your passport number and a photograph of your passport. Foreigners can link international credit cards (Visa, MasterCard) to WeChat Pay. Input your card details, and ensure your card supports international transactions. Verification might involve a small transaction to confirm the card's validity.

How do I pay for utilities & services through WeChat?

You can pay for utilities and services directly through WeChat by navigating to the "Bills" section of the Wallet menu. Keep track of your spending and transfers by regularly checking your WeChat wallet's transaction history.
