Should wine be stored on the side?

Keeping your bottles on their sides, with wine constantly in contact with the cork, you won't run the risk of having a "corked" wine. DON'T: Store your wine upright for long term. For the same reason it's recommended to store wine on its side why it is not recommended to store it upright.

How to store wine at home?

Wine storage at home is simple, even if you don't have a basement or a wine fridge. Store wine in the horizontal position, away from any direct source of heat, away from direct sunlight, and away from any source of vibration. -Talk-A-Vino Storing your wine in a horizontal position keeps the cork moist by having constant contact with the wine.

How long can you keep wine upright?

With that said, it is okay to store your wine upright for a short amount of time, which is why many some convenient or liquor stores can get away with it; they are banking on a timely sale of the bottles. I wouldn't recommend keeping bottles upright for more than a few weeks. DO: Keep your wine at a constant temperature.

Where do you store expensive wine?

Store very expensive wines in professional wine lockers. If you've bought wine that you worry about keeping for years, you may just want to have it kept in a wine locker at a local wine store or winery. They will ensure your wines are always at the perfect temperature and humidity.

Why do wine bottles need to be stored on their sides?

Storing wine bottles on their sides keeps the corks moist. This is important because if a cork dries out,it can shrink and let air into the bottle (and possibly let some wine leak out). That,in turn,can oxidize your wine,meaning it will prematurely age and its flavors will fade (it's also a pain to open a bottle with a dry,crumbly cork).

Should wine be stored upside down?

You might occasionally even see wine stored upside-down, but it's generally best to stick with horizontal storage, especially in the long term. Many cellars, lockers and other spaces for storing wines are designed for keeping bottles on their sides, so you may also find it's more efficient to keep them horizontal.

Wine Fridge: Use a wine fridge only if your Bordeaux is ready to drink. A fridge can keep wine at the perfect serving temperature, but it isn't the best option for fine wine storage over long periods of time. Self-Service ...

The amount of wine that can be stored in a wine locker depends on the size of the locker. Wine lockers are typically designed to hold six, twelve, or twenty four bottles, but can be customized to fit larger collections as
