

Do I need to inform my neighbors before installing solar panels?

There is generally no need to inform your neighbors before installing solar panels. You don't need to inform themsince solar panels are designed to minimize reflection. Even if your neighbor is looking directly at your solar panels, it's unlikely to affect them significantly.

Can HOAs install solar panels in New York?

It's likely that you'll need to get permission from your HOA to install panels to your home. When you install solar, your HOA has the right to make sure you or your installer have all the necessary permits to operate, your panels meet certain design requirements, or dictate the placement of your solar panels.

How do HOAs regulate solar panels?

Each state has its own set of laws regarding solar access, which can influence how HOAs govern solar panel installations. For instance, some states have " solar easement provisions " that limit the ability of HOAs to restrict solar installations outright. Federal laws also play a role, particularly through policies that encourage renewable energy.


