While the word "free" implies there are no associated costs, this is not usually the case with free solar panel offers. "I have never seen an advertisement offering free solar that is not a lie," said Neil Gallagher of Brighterway Solar, a solar installation company in Florida.

Do Americans get free solar panels?

American homeowners might be eligible for federal tax credits for solar installations or state subsidies for solar energy, but not free panels. The U.S. government does not provide free solar panels, said a U.S. Department of Energy spokesperson. The department urges people to report scams to the .

Does the Department of energy offer free solar panels?

The Department of Energy and the Solar Energy Technologies Office have got you covered! The Department of Energy is aware of claims of offers for free solar panels or that solar companies must provide solar panels for free if requested.

Are free solar panels a good idea?

The Facebook post promising free solar panels links to another site with a disclaimer: "No Cost" means that you may not be required to put any money down at the time of installation if you qualify. Solar is not free, but it usually saves homeowners thousands of dollars more than the initial investment.
