How do you store frozen food at a grocery store?

When food shopping, pick-up refrigerated and frozen foods just prior to checkout. Refrigerated foods should be cold ($40\text{--}45\text{F}$), and frozen foods should be solid with no evidence of thawing ($0\text{--}5\text{F}$). Refrigerated and frozen food should be bagged together. After shopping, drive straight home and store food in the refrigerator or freezer.
