What is WeChat Pay & how does it work?

WeChat Pay will now enable foreign users to link international cards, enhancing mobile payments and boosting the country's opening up.

How many banks does WeChat Pay support?

As of 2019, WeChat Pay supports a total of 408 banks (288 savings cards, 117 credit cards, and 3 foreign card organizations). Up to 10 bank cards of the same name (including credit card) can be bound to each WeChat payment account. Non-continental bank cards only support binding credit cards.

Does WeChat Pay support international credit card holders?

Since WeChat Pay's international credit card function is still in its pilot program, we'd like to reiterate that not all payment functions are accessible to international credit card holders. Through the wallet section and the integrated browser of WeChat, users can perform a variety of transactions using WeChat Pay, including and not limited to:

How many bank cards can be bound to a WeChat payment account?

Up to 10 bank cards of the same name (including credit card) can be bound to each WeChat payment account. Non-continental bank cards only support binding credit cards. When binding, you need to verify the card number, valid period, CVN2; US, Canada needs to verify the billing address.

Does WeChat Pay work in China?
