How much do solar photovoltaic installers make a year?

The median annual wage for solar photovoltaic installers was \$48,800in May 2023. Employment of solar photovoltaic installers is projected to grow 48 percent from 2023 to 2033,much faster than the average for all occupations. About 4,100 openings for solar photovoltaic installers are projected each year, on average, over the decade.
