A few research institutions have developed solar panels with efficiency ratings of 30% or higher in recent years, but this technology has not been adopted in mainstream manufacturing processes, so there isn't a solar manufacturer today that sells panels with this level of efficiency. Are solar panels more efficient than other solar panels?

Some solar panel manufacturers produce solar panels with higher efficiency ratings than others. For example, we found SunPower in-house solar panels are nearly 23% efficient compared to other solar panels that may have an efficiency rating closer to 19% or 20%.

Are solar panels worth it?

Solar panels can generate major savings if you're trying to reduce your electricity costs, carbon emissions or both. The primary factor in determining whether or not solar panels are worthwhile for you is the cost you're currently paying for electricity. The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run.

How much does solar installation cost?

Installation labor accounts for around 5.5% of the total cost of a residential solar project, according to a 2022 report from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That amounts to \$1,375 for a \$25,000 solar project.

Are high-efficiency solar panels a good investment?

High-efficiency solar panels produce excellent energy, leading to better savings on electricity bills and quicker ROI. High-quality solar panels offer better power production, leading to fewer panels in your installation. Fewer panels also mean less crowding and more roof space.

How are solar companies rated?
