How do you install a solar system?

Once the solar panels are installed, the system needs to be activated. This involves interconnecting the solar panels, installing the inverter, and commissioning the system. During this step, installers should note that as long as the solar panels are receiving sunlight, they have an open circuit voltage.

#### How do I choose a battery for a DIY solar panel?

For any battery-backed DIY solar panel system, choosing a PWM charge controller, rather than a MPPT, will be less efficient, but more cost effective.

#### How to connect multiple solar panels?

If you have multiple solar panels, you will need to connect them in either a series or a parallel connection. As in the image, you will connect the solar panels to the charge controller (regulator), then the battery, then the inverter. Step 5.

#### How do I choose a home solar panel system?

For grid-tie home solar panels,take a look at your electricity bills. You can design your system to meet your average monthly kilowatt hour consumption. #### How do I manually place solar panels?
