Do micro- and small enterprises have a grid connection in North India?

Micro- and small enterprise surveys from rural North India are analysed (N = 2,004). 34% of MSEs have no grid connection, despite complete village electrification. Variation in grid reliability did not explain connection rates nor low consumption. Electricity policy reform targeting productive use must consider wealth constraints.

Is revenue village grid supply reliability a determinant of rural MSE grid connection?

The effective exclusion of revenue village grid supply reliability as a determinant of rural MSE grid connection and utilisation in our sample provides a starting point into understanding electricity needs and growth constraints of micro- and small non-farm enterprises in rural northern India.

Are micro-small and medium-size enterprises the backbone of economies?

Micro-, small, and medium-size enterprises (MSMEs) form the backbone of economies. Across the 16 countries we examine, MSMEs account for two-thirds of business employment in advanced economies--and almost four-fifths in emerging economies--as well as half of all value added.

How many rural workers are employed by MSME?

While MSME revenues represent a small share of the broader Indian economy, they employ approximately one fifth of the rural working population (NSSO, 2017, 2019).

Are microenterprise workers self-employed?

In India, Kenya, and Nigeria, microenterprises employ more than 90 percent of MSME workers, of whom some 90 percent are self-employed own-account workers and contributing family members. They face challenges of particularly low productivity. 17

Do microenterprises increase aggregate productivity?

As these emerging economies climb the income ladder, microenterprises may grow their revenue and productivity, but most tend to stay small or medium size. 18 As a result, MSMEs as a group continue to contribute larger shares to national output, and in that sense, MSMEs directly lift aggregate productivity growth.
