Why did WeChat have two different platforms?

WeChat eventually built two different platforms to avoid this problem; one for the Chinese mainland (Weixin) and one for the rest of the world (WeChat). The problem existed because WeChat's servers were all located in China and thus subjected to its censorship rules.

Does WeChat allow group video calls?

WeChat allows group video calls. Weixin, the Chinese version of WeChat, operates from China under Chinese law, which includes strong censorship provisions and interception protocols.

Does WeChat show the location of users in China?

In April 2022, WeChat announced that it will start displaying the location of users in China every time they post on a public account. Meanwhile, overseas users on public accounts will also display the country based on their IP address. “Moments” () is WeChat's brand name for its social feed of friends' updates.
