

What items can be stored in elevator lockers

Are enclosed elevator lobbies required for underground buildings?

Where enclosed elevator lobbies are required for underground buildings, such lobbies shall comply with Section 405.4.3. 3. Where an area of refuge is required and an enclosed elevator lobby is provided to serve as an area of refuge, the enclosed elevator lobby shall comply with Section 1009.6.

What equipment do elevators need?

1. Elevator equipment. 2. Elevator hoistway lighting. 3. Ventilation and cooling equipment for elevator machine rooms, control rooms, machine spaces and control spaces. 4. Elevator car lighting. 3007.8.1 Protection of wiring or cables.

Can elevator door assemblies be electrically locked?

The section states that where permitted by the occupancy chapters, door assemblies separating the elevator lobby from the exit access may be electrically locked, provided that the long list of criteria is met. This list includes: Initiation of the fire alarm system by other than the manual fire alarm boxes unlocks the elevator lobby door.

Are elevator lobby doors code compliant?

Some state and local building codes have added similar language pertaining to elevator lobby doors, however, the IBC does not currently include a section specifically addressing elevator lobby door locks - only the requirement that elevator lobbies have at least one code-compliant means of egress.

Can delayed egress locks be used to secure elevator lobby doors?

Depending on the use group, the IBC may allow delayed egress locks to be used as a means of securing elevator lobby doors, but the required signage can be confusing for building occupants using the doors during periods when they are not secured.

Do fire service access elevator lobbies need a smoke barrier?

The fire service access elevator lobby shall be enclosed with a smoke barrier having a fire-resistance rating of not less than 1 hour, except that lobby doorways shall comply with Section 3007.6.3. Exception: Enclosed fire service access elevator lobbies are not required at the levels of exit discharge. 3007.6.3 Lobby doorways.
