Who should I hire for a solar panel installation?

We recommend hiring an installer certified by the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP), which provides quality credential programs for solar panel installation professionals. Also, hire ones who are insured to protect you from liability. Ask your potential hire for any references and reach out to them.

How do I choose a solar panel installation contractor?

A solar panel installation contractor should have licensing and insurance to legally practice in most states. When you're hiring a pro, look for one with at least three years of experience in their field and get quotes from at least three different pros before making your decision.

Do I need a license to install solar panels?

Not all states require a solar contractor to be licensed, so check your state solar certification and licensing requirements.
