

# Can I put a locker next to the curtains

Can Curtains hang above the floor?

Do not allow your curtains to hang above the floor. When they stop a couple of inches above the floor, it can make the ceilings look lower. For curtains to look full, the panels should have a combined width of at least double the window width. If you have two panels, each one should equal the window's width.

Where should curtain rods be placed?

Let's dive into the do's and don'ts of curtain placement. DON'T position your curtain rod directly above the window frame. Hanging your curtain rod just above the window frame brings the eyes down, making your ceiling look and feel shorter. DO position your curtain rod directly below the ceiling.

Can you hang curtains on both sides of a window?

DO hang panels on both sides of the window. If space allows, use panels on both sides of the window (even on narrow windows). This creates symmetry and balance within the room. DON'T use just one panel on each side of the window. If your curtains panels are not very wide, it can cheapen the look. When open, they appear insufficient.

Should curtains be hung over windows?

For example, hanging curtains taller and wider than your windows will make the room and windows feel larger. You may also need to hang curtains over windows with existing blinds or use a method that doesn't require drilling into the walls for apartment living. Also, consider how long the curtains or drapes will hang below the window.

Should curtains be pulled closed to cover a window?

Consider the width of your window and the curtains when you're purchasing, even if you don't ever plan on closing them. We rarely pull our curtains all the way closed (we have blinds and tend to use those instead). But, we always make sure to get curtains that theoretically could be pulled closed to cover the window. Why?

How do I make curtains more privacy?

Try extending an extra-wide curtain rod from wall to wall. Hang multiple panels across the rod to create a softening repetition effect, and measure the overall length to ensure each panel can cover a whole window. When it's dark outside and the lights are on in your home, you'll want the option to pull your curtains entirely shut to ensure privacy.

Additionally, eyelet and patterned curtains can help make a living room look more inviting and add a pop of colour and personality to a room. Can you combine roman shades with curtains? Yes, ...

Turn off your ad blocker to view content. DON'T use a narrow rod that forces your curtains to cover part of the window. When your curtains cover part of the window, this limits the sunlight your room receives and
